

## How to Connect to Fermilab VPN on an iOS device e.g. iPhone or iPad

1) Purchase (free) and install the Cisco AnyConnect VPN app from the iOS App store



2) On the first launch, the AnyConnect client will prompt you for permission to extend the VPN capabilities of the device. Allow this.



3) Tap on "Add VPN Connection". Enter a memorable description and enter `vpn.fnal.gov` as the server address. Leave certificate set to "Automatic". Other items can be left as default. Tap "Save" to store Fermi VPN configuration.



Note: Multiple configurations can be created allowing VPN connections to other sites using Cisco AnyConnect with available licenses.

4) Tap on the name of the VPN configuration to connect.




5) Switch slider from Off to On to initiate VPN connection for selected location.



6) Enter username and password. Fermi VPN uses the Services account and password for authentication. Tap "Connect" to authenticate.



7) If authentication is successful a standard notice banner will appear. Tap "Accept" to complete connection. Tap "Reject" to disagree with notice and cancel connection.



8) If connection is successful, VPN status will change to Connected. Additionally a VPN icon will appear in the top menu bar next to other network connection indicators like Wi-Fi, 3G, etc. Other information can be viewed in Status Overview, Graphs and Diagnostics.




Note:

The Cisco AnyConnect VPN connection will be maintained even after exiting the client app. This allows the use of the VPN connection by other apps on the device.



Warning:

You must manually disconnect the VPN connection by opening the AnyConnect app and move the slider from On to Off.



Note:

A new VPN item may appear in the Settings app. While VPN configurations can be edited from here, a connection can NOT be established despite the VPN on/off switch. Connections must be made from with the AnyConnect client app.
